WORKERS' RIGHTS AT CALL CENTERS IN THE PHILIPPINES

Workers at AT&T contractor Alorica in the Philippines provide assistance to US customers every day.

Filipino workers are paid less than \$2/hour and report harsh conditions. They have organized a union to win improvements and respect, but face severe retaliation from management.

Alorica has terminated union members and brought trumped-up criminal charges against union officers. In September 2018, the union filed a Notice of Strike.



The United Employees of Alorica have the following demands:

- Drop the criminal charges filed against the union leaders
- Reinstate the terminated officers of UEA
